## We were approved to become the Certified NPO Corporation!

Among various activities in 2018, the most successful news we had was the approval for becoming the certified NPO corporation.

Certified NPO corporations consist only 2% of all non-profit organizations in Japan, 28 out of 700 non-profit organizations in Shizuoka Prefecture, and the second organization to be approved in the Ito City.

The certified NPO corporation is proven through legitimate testing and the jurisdiction that our activities are uphold by the majority, our management body is legitimately conducted, and we disclose information with high transparency. Which are trustworthy to be certified as a non-profit corporation with "a high utility of public service in an objective perspective."

It had been such a long long journey, but we finally have achieved this goal with so many people's support. And we are truly thankful to all of you!

We will continue to strive for becoming an organization with more transparency in creating further differences for the children and society. And we sincerely thank you for your continuous support.

**Mental Coaching**

Total of **8** seminars and **67** attendance  
In mental coaching seminars, we aim to develop children's ability to resolve problems independently in times of adversity, by training their ability to self analyze and to have depth of understanding in their selves and others. For 2018, we conducted 8 seminars for junior high school students and parents by the instructor Ms. Yukako Hagiwara.

Over the year, we had come to a conclusion that students in a teenage generation are vulnerable to the influence of their parents, and it is difficult to make children change without parents' cooperation to reflect their own problems. Therefore, we will proceed to conduct mental coaching seminars mainly for parents and coaches in 2019.

**Fence Project (May - present)**

Fence Project started with our hope to provide an environment where children in Nepal can play soccer whenever they want. With many people's help in Japan, we were able to gather money through cloud funding and had allowed us to begin the construction from May.

We needed to build fences around the vacant land in order to practice, which was in middle of the farming land that had banned us from practicing soccer because of the damage it can bring to their crops. Now it had become a recreational circle for local children and FC REALE Nepal is able to practice soccer throughout the year.

**World Friends Project & Heroes Project & Coffee Project**

World Friends Project collects children's soccer/training shoes in Japan that are no longer in use but still usable, and delivers to the children in Nepal that doesn't have money to buy their own shoes. We also aim to make a connection between children in two countries for bringing mutual understanding.

Heroes Project is to support professional soccer players in Nepal to become a heroic symbol for children in Nepal. It is difficult to get good quality soccer shoes in Nepal due to financial difficulties and its secluded market. REALE WORLD will directly deliver good quality soccer shoes from Japan to professional soccer players in Nepal. Many people had cooperated for this project, including the professional soccer players in Japan, and had brought many joy to the players in Nepal.



REALE WORLD had began an import business using the Nepali coffee (Himcafe). Its aim is to support their independence by increasing the sales of small farmers and women working in coffee business.

At the same time, all the net profit we gain from this business will go to our projects in Nepal; grassroots activity in Nepal, funds for Heroes Projects, charity to orphanage in Nepal, etc.
