You can change your life by your effort and ingenuity!

We want them to learn that they can change their life by their effort and ingenuity even if they are born in Nepal, where the class society and the economic disparity are expanding. FC REALE operates with thought of never giving up in life no matter what the challenge. They relate this message through continuous soccer practice and games.

In 2023, over 150 children aged 6 to 15 participated in the REALE Football Academy. They learned the importance of greetings, manners, effort, and cooperation. They also reflected on their life-style habits, aiming to develop helpful resourcefulness to live independently. Starting our activities in Nepal over 10 years ago, former children now serve as coaches for FC REALE and

instructors for physical education classes in local schools. They pass on what they were taught to younger generations, embodying the spirit of paying it forward. During winter, FC REALE NEPAL held a soccer league for children called REALE CUP. The league lasted 3 months and was held every Saturday. We provided the opportunity to feel the results of their hard practice in Nepal.

Nepali children wake up early! Morning practice sessions are held 6 days a week, from 6:00 AM to 8:00 AM.



FC Reale and 16 local schools and clubs participated in the REALE CUP held in Nepal from December to February.

This is extremely helpful in an environment where finding a job through sports is difficult.

Urawa Red Heart-full Club came to Nepal! International exchange with the soccer club and local school students.

On August 9th and 10th, coaches from Urawa Red Heart-full Club visited Nepal as part of the "Heart-full Soccer in Asia."

REALE WORLD coordinated and supported this interaction as well.

6 coaches led the program, which focused on the values of "effort," "enjoyment," and "compassion." 200 children from 2 local schools and FC REALE NEPAL joined to experience the enjoyment of exercise.

The event was a significant learning experience for everyone.



Japan and Nepal International Exchange Soccer Tournament "U-15 REALE CUP 2023" was held.

On December 25th and 26th, Japanese children participated in U-15 REALE CUP hosted in Nepal.

The participants were 12 children who joined the program of Seeds called "Beyond Borders CAMP2023."

They were divided into 5 joint Japanese-Nepalese teams alongside 48 Nepalese children, including the REALE Kids from Madiapur Thimi city. Over the span of two days, they played in multiple league matches. The Japanese children were able



to experience Nepal's spicy foods, uneven grounds, showers without hot water, and practiced communicating in English with Nepalese children. At the same time it was also a valuable opportunity for Nepalese children to directly interact with Japanese.

Reale supporters and high school students participated as volunteers.

On March, supporters of REALE WORLD and local high school students from Japan visited Nepal as volunteers to deliver donated shoes to children.

After engaging in volunteer activities, they participated in morning training sessions hosted by FC REALE NEPAL and experienced visiting the homes of the locals.

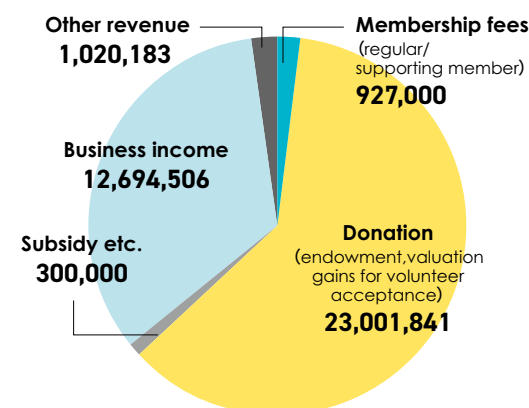

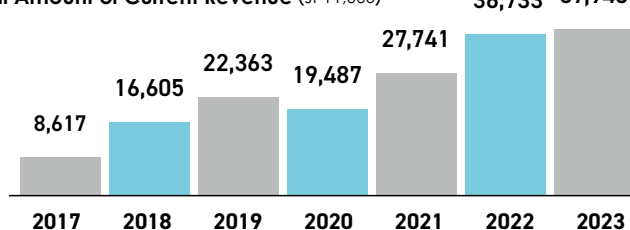

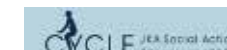
